Your task is to write yourself letter, to be opened at the end of secondary school (or the end of Year 7 if you prefer).

<u>LO: To write a letter to yourself in the future.</u>	
Success Criteria:	Example:
First person	This is a letter from you, to you! Use I, ME, MY
Formality	You are writing to yourself so you can choose how formally you want to write.
Sentence openers	As I sit here... In the future... Even though... When I think about.... After that...
Range of punctuation	Show off to your future self! . , () - : ;

What you could include...

- How you are feeling about leaving St Mary & St John and moving to your secondary school.
- Anything you are worried about or excited for.
- Include any questions you have or things you are unsure of, as you may know the answers by the time you read the letter in the future.
- Information about what your life has been like over the last few weeks as it will all seem very strange to us in the future.
- What are your dreams, your goal and your ambitions? How would you like to improve yourself or change by the end of secondary school?
- Advice for yourself or something that you would like yourself to remember.
- Anything else you would like to include... it's your letter!

When you have finished, take some time to read back over what you have written and think about the advice you have given.

Lastly, put it in an envelope (decorate it if you want to) and put it somewhere safe where you won't lose it. You could set a reminder on a phone or a computer in case you forget about it.
